

INDIANA TRIO BOARD OF DIRECTORS SCHOLARSHIPS

The Indiana TRIO Board of Directors has established a scholarship program to help finance higher education. All students who participate in a Student Support Services or the Ronald McNair Program in Indiana and who meet the eligibility requirements should be encouraged to apply for the Indiana Board of Directors Scholarship. To be considered, an applicant must be a participant:

- in a Student Support Services or McNair program in the State of Indiana,
- who demonstrates academic excellence and co-curricular/community involvement in college

Three full-time awards of \$1,000 each and two part-time awards of \$500 will be paid to the students selected as the winners of an Indiana TRIO Board of Directors Scholarships. The Indiana TRIO Scholarship Committee, appointed by Indiana TRIO's President, will select the recipient of the scholarship. Three applications from each TRIO program will be accepted for each of these two scholarships.

To apply, students must complete the Indiana TRIO Board of Director's Scholarship Application Form and return this with a personal narrative, a copy of their current academic transcript to their TRIO Program Director. A photo release form and photograph will be requested only from selected applicants at a later time.

The Program Director or TRIO staff member will complete a supporting nomination form and send the complete application packet in one scanned PDF document by **email** to the Scholarship Committee Chair no later than **11:59 p.m. EST on March 29th**, to Anita Watson, Indiana TRIO Scholarship Chairperson (email anita.watson@pfw.edu). The scholarship recipient will be selected on the basis community service, TRIO involvement, academic achievement, essay, and TRIO staff recommendation. The winner will be notified by his/her Program Director and/or the Indiana TRIO Scholarship Chairperson at the end of April. All information requested must be submitted together and before the deadline or the candidate will not be considered.

Scholarship payment will be made in September/October in one lump sum after proof of enrollment for the fall term has been received by the Scholarship Chairperson along with a current mailing address. The check will be mailed to the recipient's current mailing address and payable to the student.
